To Parents/ Guardians

1. It is the earnest request of the Management to the Parents/ Guardians to be in touch with the Principal and know from him/ her the progress of their sons/ daughters/ Wards from time to time.
2. On the day of admission the parents/Guardians should come to the College and sign before the Principal a declaration relating to the conduct of their sons/ daughters/wards.
3. After the mid term examination a progress report will be sent to them. They are requested to peruse it sign and return it in time.
4. If they receive any communication from the College with regard to their sons / daughters/ wards, they are requested to come to the college meet the Principal and discuss with him the matter on hand and cooperate.
5. It is hoped that the parents / guardians will realise that the progress of their sons / daughters/ wards is a responsibility which they have to share with the principal and other teachers and co-operative with them always.
6. The College is managed by Vidyavardhaka Sangha (R), Shirva and the College is thirty six years old. The Sangha appeals earnestly to the parents guardians and others of the locality to strengthen its hands by their goodwill and munificence and co-operate in making the college not just another College but the Best College of all.

College Notice Board. It is the responsibility of every student to look up the Notice Board and get the relevant information and the College is not responsible for any loss or inconvenience caused to him/her on account of his/her failure to do so.

16. If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority the concerned students shall be given liberty to explain & if his explanations is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel him/ her from the institution.
17. students should not enter into an altercation with the lecturers in the classroom. Any disobedience shown during the class hours will be seriously dealt with.
18. The college will not be responsible for the conduct of the students outside its premise. However it will take note of the offence if any and action will be initiated according to the nature and magnitude of the offence.
19. Use of Cellphones by the students on the campus is banned. Cellphones if found with students will be confiscated.
20. Use of tobacco, alcohol or any other intoxicants is banned in the premises.
21. Educational tours/ Industry visit/ Field visits are to be organized with the prior permission of the Principal. For all such programmes written permission of the parents is required.
22. Booing, whistling or producing animal sounds in the lecture hall or in the College premises is forbidden.
23. All the students of 3 year degree course must wear the prescribed uniform. The dress material should be in the prescribed stitching format.
24. Disciplinary action will be initiated against the students violating the dress code.

THE COLLEGE

The new College Building with all facilities was inaugurated by His Holiness Sri Vibudhesha Tirtha Swamiji of March 1990 under the presidentship of Sri K Amarnath Shetty Ex. Minister Govt. of Karnataka. Permanent Affiliation has been granted to the college by the Mangalore University and the institution is recognised by the U.G .C New Delhi under 2 (f) and 12 (b) of the U.G. C Act.

The College is re-accredited at B++ Grade by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council in Feb. 2017.

To Promote sports and games activities a separate wing KREEDA BHAVAN with all indoor games facilities has been constructed for the use of the pupils and people.

A separate library building with all modern facilities costing over Rs. twenty lakhs was inaugurated by Sri S.M Krishna former Governor of Maharashtra & the present External Affairs Minister, Government of India.

April 6, 2009 was another milestone in the History of the Institution. Women's Hostel constructed under U.G.C special scheme of over Rs.65 lakhs was inaugurated by Dr. N.R Shetty, Former Vice Chancellor of Bangalore University.

A new block was inaugurated on 18th April 2016 by Sri Manjunath Bhandari a renowned educationist. Constructed at a cost of Rs. 45 lakhs, the new block has facilities for computer lab, classrooms, faculty room and rest rooms for boys and girls.

The college is located in a peaceful and serene surroundings. The building and other facilities of the College are spread out in about 15 acres of expanse. The campus provides an ideal atmosphere for education. The College has completed

4. Students should not go out of or enter the classroom without the permission of the lecturer after the class has begun.
5. Students admitted to the College are expected to maintain a high standard of behaviour and discipline both inside and outside the College.

10. Participation in political agitation demonstration and strike of any kind is prohibited. Students indulging in such activities will be summarily expelled from the College.
11. Sportsmen of the College are prohibited from playing against the College team.
12. When students participate in inter-collegiate competition matches and tournaments they should conduct themselves well, obey their captains/ managers and should not do anything that might bring discredit to themselves and to the College.

Students should note that all these scholarships, fee concessions and financial assistances are granted subject to satisfactory attendance, progress and conduct.

Attendance

- Attendance will be marked at the beginning of each class. Students who are late to the class will not get attendance
- The minimum attendance required to qualify a student for the University Examination is 75% of the actual number of working periods in each subject.
- Shortage of attendance will not be condoned. If a student fails to put in the prescribed minimum of attendance in any one of the subjects he/she will not be permitted to take the University Examination.
- Attendance at tests and class examinations is compulsory. Those who absent themselves from tests and class examinations or do not show progress at these will not be permitted to appear for the University Examination.
- The Student who cannot attend a class for legitimate reasons should obtain permission from the respective lecturer to absent himself from that class.
- A student who wishes to avail leave for less than 3 days should apply for the same in the Leave Note Sheet attached to this Calender with Parents signature.
- If leave is required for more than 3 days one should apply for the same to the Principal through the class teacher duly signed by the parent/guardian.
- The name of a student is liable to be struck off the rolls if he/she justifiable reason to the satisfaction of the principal.

Rules of discipline

- The working day is divided into two sessions. The morning session is from 9.50 a.m. - 12.50 p.m and the afternoon session is from 1.50 p.m. - 4.30 p.m.
- Five minutes before the 2 classes commence both in the forenoon and the afternoon a bell is given for the students to assemble in their respective classes.

Eligibility for Admission to the Degree Courses

Candidates who have passed the Pre-University examination conducted by any the Board of Pre University Education in Karnataka, or any other examination recognised by the Mangalore University as equivalent there to are eligible for admission to B.A,& B.Com Degree Courses. Application in the prescribed form along with a registration fee of Rs 50/- each should be submitted to the principal soon after the publication of the results of the Pre University Examination on or before the last date notified on the College Notice Board.

Rules of Admission:

1. Application should be complete in all respects and should be submitted on or before the date specified. Incomplete or late applications are liable to be rejected.
2. A recent passport size photograph of the candidate should be affixed to the application in the space provided for it.
3. Admission to the College is granted only after an interview with the candidate and his/her parent or guardian. Candidates are called for interview at the discretion of the Principal.
4. However, registration of an application or appearance at the interview does not guarantee the admission.
5. The list of the selected candidates will be notified on the College Notice Board.
6. Candidates selected for admission should come to the College on the specified date with their parents/guardians and both the candidates & parents/ guardians should sign a declaration in the presence of the Principal.
7. The Candidate who does not present himself/herself on the specified date with his/her parents/guardian, or who refuses to sign the declaration will not be admitted.
8. Candidate selected for admission should submit the following documents at the time of admission:
 - a) S.S.L.C and P.U.C Marks Cards
 - b) Transfer and conduct certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended.
 - c) Migration/Eligibility Certificate

(Note: Migration Certificate should be obtained from the University from which the candidate is migrating Eligibility Certificate should be obtained from the University to which the candidate seeks admission)

d) Three copies of the recent passport size photograph of the Candidate.

9. Admissions are made only for one year. Students are required to renew their admissions by applying afresh every year. Renewal of admission is subject to satisfactory attendance, progress and conduct of the student during the previous year.

10. When students are issued Transfer Certificates at their request, they will not be re-admitted unless it is duly approved by the College Governing Council.

11. Admission are made on the clear understanding that those admitted will fully accept the rules and regulations which are in force in the college and which may come into force from time to time.

12. The Principal may refuse admission to any one without assigning any reason.

13. All admissions are provisional and are subject to the approval of Mangalore University.

Fee Regulations:

1. The academic year having been divided into two terms, the tuition fee is collected in two instalments, one at the time of admission and the other at the beginning of the next semester.

2. Fees once paid are not refundable.

3. A student who leaves the College any time during the academic year will have to pay the fees for the whole year.

4. Fine for late payment will be collected at Rs. 2/- for the first five days and thereafter at Rs. 5 /- for the next five days. If the payment remains unpaid on the last day prescribed for payment of fees with fines, the defaulter's name will be struck off the College Register. If re-admitted thereafter, he/she shall pay the fees with fine for all days of delay and re-admission fee.
