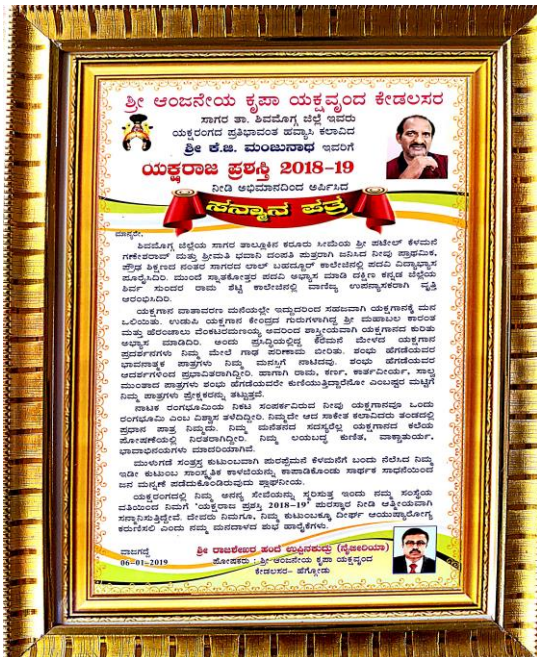
Awards to Prof. K G Manjunath

Yakshagana is a traditional narrative art form having long history. It is believed that this art form began during 11th century. It is valued as theatre form narrating and recreating ancient Indian epics and legends. It contains all aspects of Bharathamuni's Natya Shashtra, i.e, Angika, Aharya, Vachika and Sathvika. The art form is more popular in coastal Karnataka and Malnad districts. The certificate course on Yakshagana is conducted every year to motivate the students and to inculcate interest in the art form.

Prof K.G. Manjunath is a well known performer in the field of Badaguthittu Yakshagana. He conducts workshops on Yakshagana in different schools and institutions during vacations. He has also enacted various roles in theatre. Considering his contribution to the field of Yakshagana as a performer, trainer and resource person, he has been honored by different art organisations and associations.

Awards to Prof. Murugeshi T

Prof. T Murugeshi of Dept. of Ancient History and Archaeology, MSRS College being felicitated by the Dept. of Archaeology, Museums and Heritage, Government of Karnataka at Hampi Utsava, 27-29 January 2023.

This honour was bestowed on Prof T Murugeshi for the all-round contribution of the Dept. of Ancient History and Archaeology to broadening the horizon of history, prehistory, archaeology and heritage of coastal Karnataka. Though seminal contributions had been made towards studying the art and architecture of the region by historians like Dr. Gururaja Bhat, the pre-historic footprint was almost absent apart from Megalithic sites which are in fact proto-historic. Serious research started from the 1980s, and the Dept. from MSRS College started contributing significantly from the 1990s through active fieldwork. As a result, several sites have been discovered as regards to pre-historic rock art, habitations, and tools. The study of epigraphy has been bolstered with the discovery, preservation and decipherment of many inscriptions in Kannada, and Tulu. Prof. Murugeshi was also congratulated especially for mentoring and nurturing talent by training a generation of students in archaeology.
